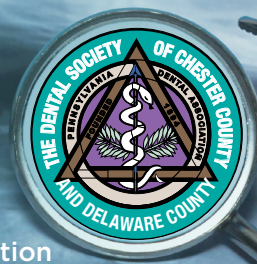

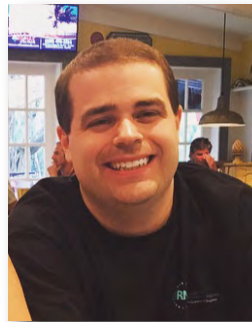

# Member Spotlight

## Jyoti Dangi, DMD

Dr. Jyoti Dangi is a general dentist practicing in the suburbs of Philadelphia. Originally from India, she moved to the United States in 2006. Dr. Dangi is an internationally trained dentist who pursued extensive education upon arriving in the US. She earned her Master's in Oral Biology, certificates in Dental Public Health and Oral Epidemiology from Harvard School of Dental Medicine in 2011 and later obtained her DMD degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine in 2014. Upon graduation, she was inducted into the Omicron Kappa Upsilon (OKU) Dental Honor Society.

Dr. Dangi has practiced dentistry in both private settings and at the non-profit organization Community Volunteers In Medicine (CVIM), which provides dental and medical care to underserved populations and low-income families without access to health insurance. She has been volunteering with CVIM since 2007, finding it a significant source of inspiration to give back to the community and improve access to oral healthcare for underserved populations. Additionally, Dr. Dangi volunteers at Give Kids A Smile (GKAS), Give Veterans A Smile (GVAS), and MOM-n-PA Dental Mission of Mercy.

Actively engaged in research and teaching, Dr. Dangi has served as an adjunct faculty member at the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine and Temple University Maurice H. Kornberg School of Dentistry. She is an active member of the American Dental Association, Pennsylvania Dental Association, and the Pennsylvania Leadership Academy. Recently, she was nominated to serve as an officer for the Dental Society of Chester County and Delaware County.

Dr. Dangi has been recognized with the 2024 PDA 10 under 10 Award. She is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists (ICD) and has been nominated for the Pierre Fauchard Academy (PFA), both leading honorary organizations committed to improving global oral health.

Committed to providing efficient, safe, and compassionate oral care to residents of Chester, Delaware, and Montgomery Counties, Dr. Dangi aims to make meaningful contributions to the field of dentistry. Her goal is to lead by example and motivate her colleagues on their shared journey, emphasizing the transformative power of community service, resilience, and a strong work ethic.

Dr. Dangi resides in Exton with her husband and their two children. Her hobbies include creating healthier versions of traditional favorite foods, traveling, exercising, and spending time with her family.

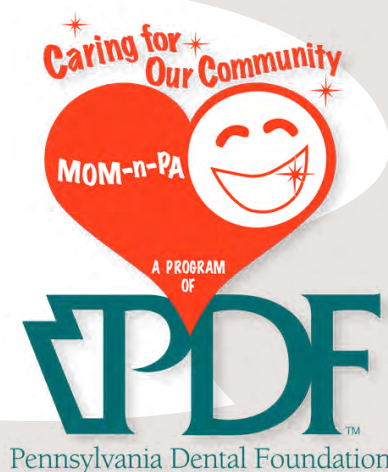

## Addressing the Workforce Issue

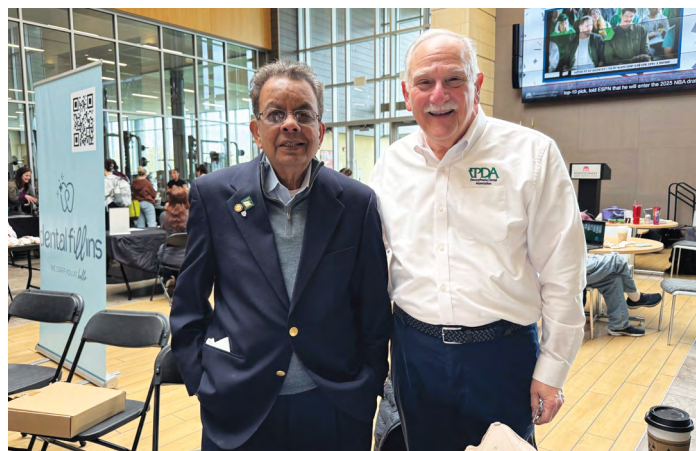

One of the chief concerns of dentists not only in Pennsylvania, but also across the country, is the workforce issue. Since the pandemic, dental practices have been hard-pressed to hire auxiliary staff: assistants, hygienists, as well as administrative staff. The ADA, as well as the PDA, have been actively involved in mitigating this challenging situation.

One avenue that the PDA has pursued is reaching out to high school students and their guidance counselors to inform them that the dental profession offers a rewarding healthcare opportunity, at different educational levels. Not all students pursue a four-year college experience, and dentistry offers positions that require two years or less of college that students or counselors may not have considered. Consequently, PDA has been getting the word out to them by means of exhibiting at college fairs, dental expos, and conferences.

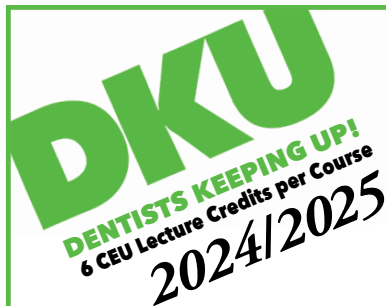
As a PDA President, I have been one such ambassador. This past year I have travelled across the Commonwealth advocating for our profession at the Pennsylvania School Counselors Conference, the Pennsylvania Association for College Admissions, the Harcum

CollegeDental Expo, and the Leadership Conference for Penn HOSA (Health Occupations Students of America). I also suggest that our members exhibit at their respective community high school college fairs to offer the same information to potential future dental auxiliaries, and PDA will supply informational materials. **Bradford Towne, DMD - Boston, MA**

**Dentoalveolar Surgery and the Management of Complications** – Dentoalveolar surgical procedures and management of potential complications useful for the general dentist will be presented in this 6 hour webinar. Upon retiring from private practice he joined Boston University Henry M. Goldman School of Dental Medicine in the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr. Towne is a diplomate of The American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and the National Board of Dental Anesthesia. He is also a Fellow in both the American College of Dentists and International College of Dentists. He is a retired Fellow of the AAOMS, MSSOMS, ADSA, and ACMOS, SSOMS.

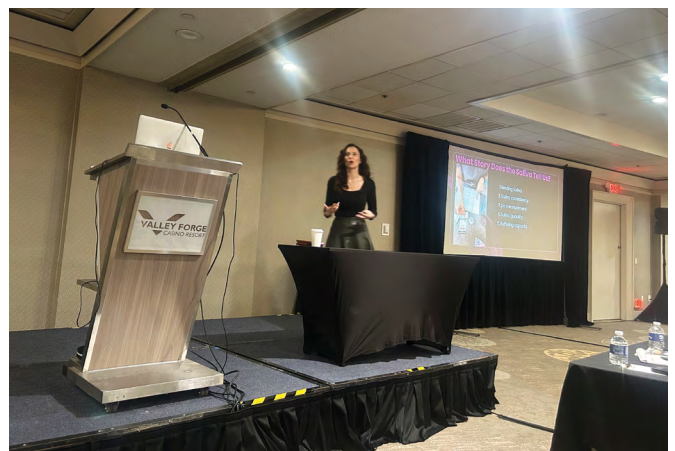

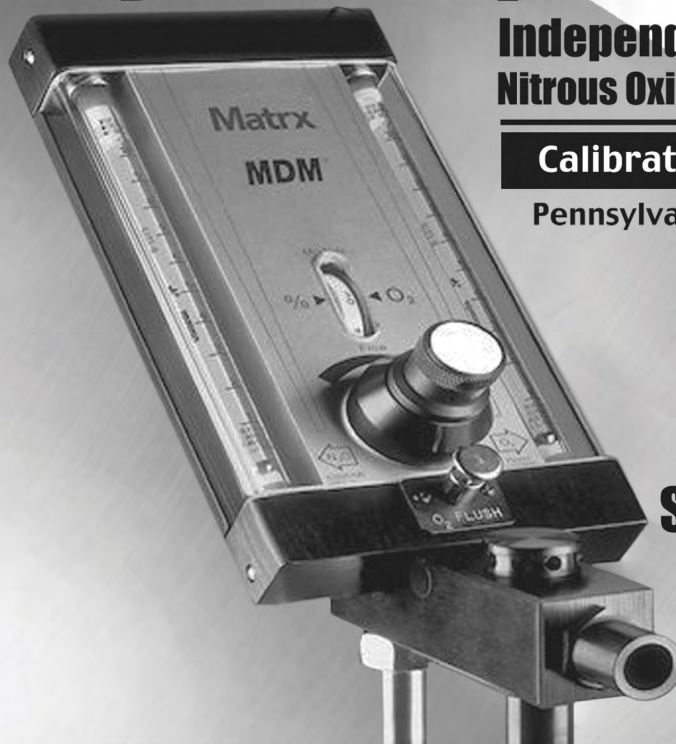
